People in Need (PIN) Ministry Community Project

Background:

The PIN Ministry is seeking volunteer construction help in building an outdoor picnic shelter at Virginia Beach Pentecostal Church to serve the homeless community. The shelter would be used for meals and other programs. Faith Works Coalition is working in Cooperation with PIN Ministries encouraging volunteer participation.

Date and Times:

Thursday and Friday October 27-28: begin framing the structure.

Monday and Tuesday October 31, November 1: finish framing and install roofing

Work days start at 8:00 AM

Tools needed:

Volunteers may bring personal tools if they have them: hammers, tape measures, etc.

Skills needed:

The construction will be led and supervised by professional contractors. Volunteers need no construction experience, just willing hands and hearts. This is a great opportunity to learn some framing and roofing skills.

Location:

The shelter is being constructed at Virginia Beach Pentecostal Church near the corner of 15th Street and Baltic Avenue.

Hatteras Island Project (Salvo) Fact Sheet

Background: The NC Emergency Management rep in Rodanthe has suggested two houses that need internal rebuilding after being flooded during hurricane Irene. If we have enough volunteers (10-12) we will work on both houses. If not, we will just work on #1.

House #1: An older house that was built in the late 1800's, it was flooded to a level of 4 ft up the walls. The interior of the house was gutted and new electrical wiring and drywall is being installed.

Work to complete:

Complete drywall installation and painting of interior walls.

Hang interior doors. Doorways are non-standard size (too small for standard doors). An experienced carpenter is needed to modify doorway and doors to match, install and trim.

Build out bathroom. Bathroom is stripped to the bare walls and some of sub-floor is missing. The only thing in place is the plumbing.

Finish rebuilding the stairway to the second level, including installing stair treads (must be cut to fit individual stairs), banister, and trim.

Once the interior is complete, level the floor and install the new flooring (laminated, already purchased) and complete trim of the interior.

House #2: House is really a double-wide trailer with exterior walls of Hardy-plank and a shingle roof. House has been gutted. Owner has ordered installation material and needs assistance restoring the interior.

Schedule: We are planning to work the week of November 7th. We are planning to drive to Hatteras Island on Sunday November 6th and be ready to start work first thing Monday am. We will return home Friday afternoon Nov 11 or Saturday am.

Transportation: Private cars. Carpooling is encouraged. It's about 2.5 hours from Virginia Beach to Salvo, and 3 hours to Hatteras Village.

Lodging: We are renting a big house in Salvo within walking distance of both work sites.

Estimated cost: \$75 pays for lodging, breakfast and lunch. Supper will be on your own to cook in or dine out.
